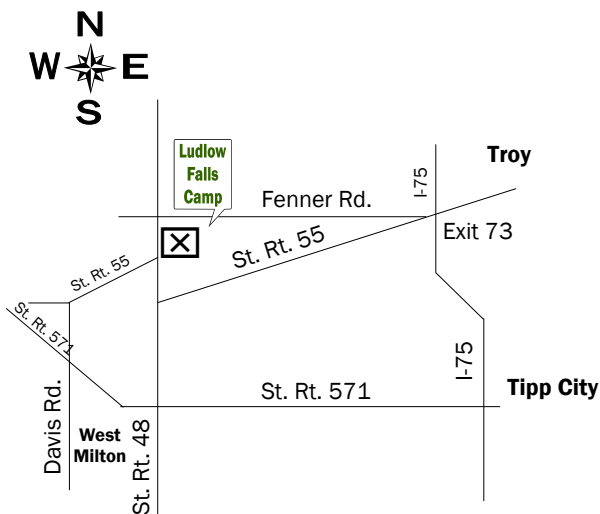

Map to Ludlow Falls Camp:



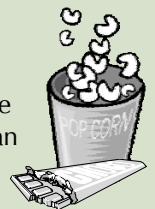
Corner Cottage Gift Shop



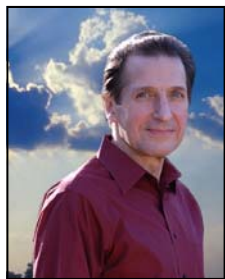

Accommodations

There are several ways for you and your family to stay on the grounds for this year's Camp Meeting.

1. **Cottages** On a very limited basis, camp owned cottages are available to families. The cost for the week is \$160, which is ~~\$20 a night~~. Due to a high demand, a cottage must be rented out for the entire week.

2. **Lodge Suites** Double room suites, sleeping four, are available for the same cost as a cottage, at \$15 a night. Single rooms may also be rented at \$10.00 per night.

3. **RV Sites** Ludlow Falls Camp has twenty-three sites available for you to park your RV, with hook up for electric and water. Dumping service available upon request. RV sites may be reserved for \$10 per night.

4. **Primitive Camping** Several primitive tent sites are available on the north side of the campground in the woods beyond the basketball court. Sites may be reserved for only \$3 per day per tent site.

** Air conditioners may be brought and used with any of the above, but will be an additional \$2 per day.
